
Old wood road right of way before construction began in 2019 showing no Live trees on the 50 foot right of way.

Trees everywhere all throughout Tonneson 14 acres! 11-1-1.52 (Shown on Deborah Kopald's illegal drone photos).




Deborah Kopald's house as shown on her own illegal drone photo.





McCarthy house on left.






Kopald distance to RR - 3000 feet
